Decision

On November 8, 2022, the AGC membership voted to approve the Multiple Degrees policy as part of a scheduled review. The policy team recommended that the existing policy be reaffirmed with no changes. The policy reads as follows:

The College recognizes that there are instances where students may require additional degrees and certificates for employment or for personal growth and satisfaction. This policy applies to any Grand Rapids Community College (GRCC) student who has received a degree from GRCC. Students may be awarded additional associate degrees subject to the following stipulations:

A.eThe Associate of General Studies degree may not be earned as ane additional degree.e

B.eNo additional associate degree will be granted in programs thate require the same Program Courses.e
