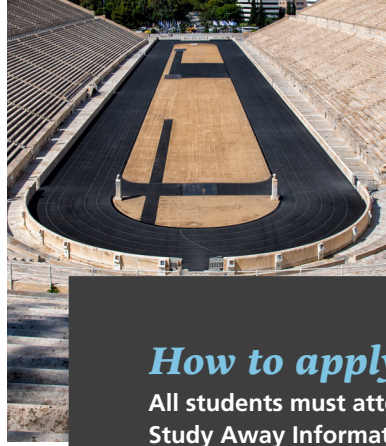

## Trip cost

**Program fee: \$6,000-\$6,500\***

What is included:

- Airfare and ground transportation
- Accommodation
- Entrance and fees to all planned activities
- Some meals

**Tuition fee: \$372 - 3 credit hours**

(calculated based on GRCC resident tuition rates)

**Potential additional expenses (costs will vary based on participant discretion):**

- All lodging, travel, entrance fees, and most meals covered by trip cost.
- Most lunches will be independent and require students to pay themselves.
- Students will also be responsible for any souvenirs or extra, independent excursions.
