

CAP 1.2.1 Student Success in Developmental Education

Approved funding for three people to obtain the knowledge and insight related to best practices and strategies for Developmental Education and Accelerated Learning by attending national conferences:

- National Association of Developmental Education conference
- Conference on Acceleration in Development Education

Also, funding to pilot a “passport” program which would include incentive based student activities to increase academic support/achievement and student engagement.

Funds requested: \$20,000 – Funds approved based on actual cost reimbursement, not to exceed \$20K.

CAP 1.3.3 Provide additional student support for Latino students

Approved funding for contingency employee assistance for this first year to help staff the initial pilot activities:

- Assist with student outreach and follow-up
- Parent orientation
- Additional ESL support
- Translation services

Funds requested: \$20,000 – Funds approved based on actual cost reimbursement, not to exceed \$20K.

CAP 3.1.2 Improve GRCC’s infrastructure and ability to develop collaborative programs to enhance student preparedness for post-secondary education through high school and community partnerships, articulation agreements, and early and middle college initiatives.

Approved funding for three people to attend the National Alliance of Concurrent Enrollment Partnerships. This national organization provides best practices for advancing quality college courses in high schools. This directly connects to the CAP work as we seek to establish an infrastructure to support high school partnerships.

Funds requested: \$3585 – Funds approved based on actual cost reimbursement, not do exceed \$3585.

We also received a request for support for the ABO program, which is CAP 1.3.4. This request was denied because the activities were funded during the previous strategic plan, and SLT funding is not intended to provide operational support.
